

ENTRY CATEGORIES AND FEES

Pre-Entry Deadline: **June 1st 2009**

must be postmarked or faxed on or before date to be eligible for discounts

FIM (World Records) Participants

Entry Fee: \$550* (*must be postmarked by June 1st, 2009*)

Entry fee after June 2nd or at the event: \$600*

All riders must hold a valid FIM International License issued by the AMA or the home FIM national affiliate of foreign riders. Contact BUB now to initiate the license and machine documentation process. We will send you your licensing application and FIM information checklist. All FIM Competitors must submit their license paperwork to BUB by the deadline (June 12th, 2009). This entry is conducted under the competition rules of the FIM.

In addition to the FIM information that you must submit to BUB, you are required to complete your Entry Form and submit your fees prior to June 1st, 2009. FIM entry fee includes unlimited runs, an event participant T-shirt & goodie bag, four (4) pit crew passes, gate discount coupons (max 15) for additional crew, eligibility for World Records, prize money and awards, provided all criteria are fulfilled.

**New entries not guaranteed on the Salt. Entrants that are not pre-registered will not be guaranteed registration at the event.*

AMA (National Records) Participants

Pre Entry Fee: \$400* (*must be postmarked by June 1st, 2009*)

Entry fee after June 2nd or at the event: \$600*

AMA entry fee includes unlimited runs, event participant T-shirt & goodie bag, four (4) pit crew passes, gate discount coupons (max 15) for additional crew, eligibility for National Records, prize money and awards, provided all criteria are fulfilled.

**New entries not guaranteed on the Salt. Entrants that are not pre-registered will not be guaranteed registration at the event.*

'Run Wat-cha Brung' Participants

Entry Fee: \$150* (*must be postmarked by June 1st, 2009*)

Entry fee after June 2nd or at the event: \$250*

Entry fee includes a 'Run Wat-cha Brung' entrant T-shirt & goodie bag, two passes down the salt flats and your official timing slip. **Pre-register by June 1st, 2009 and receive a Free gate pass (for a savings of \$80 for the week)** Gate discount coupons (max 3) for additional crew available upon request.

**New entries not guaranteed on the Salt. Entrants that are not pre-registered will not be guaranteed registration at the event.*

Additional Class

Fee: \$175 ea AMA

\$225 ea FIM

An Additional Class fee applies where the same motorcycle & rider make a change to the original entered class. Additional Class can be submitted at the same time, or after the original entry using the supplemental 'Additional Class' form. Additional class pre-entry is recommended if you plan on running in two classes, it will save time and paperwork in registration. If a 2nd rider is entering on the same bike, but in a different class- a separate entry is required. If the 2nd rider is in the same class see 'Additional Rider'. Additional Class fee includes unlimited runs, eligibility for National Records, prize money and awards, provided all criteria are fulfilled.

Additional Rider

Fee: \$175 ea AMA

\$225 ea FIM

Additional Rider fee applies where the same motorcycle & class has a 2nd rider. Additional Rider can be submitted at the same time, or after the original entry using the supplemental Additional Rider forms. Additional rider pre-entry is recommended if you plan on running two or more riders, it will save time and paperwork in registration. A separate form is required for each rider in addition to the original rider. If the subsequent riders will be running the motorcycle in a different class, an separate full entry is required. Additional Rider fee includes unlimited runs, event participant T-shirt & goodie bag, eligibility for prize money and awards, provided all criteria are fulfilled.

Spectators

Fee: \$20 per person, per day OR \$80 full week

Advance sales for gate passes available through BUB Racing up to July 31st, 2009.

Additional Notes:

- 1) Please request your motorcycle number prior to submitting entry form (530-272-4310). Bike numbers as well as the AMA class will need to be indicated on the motorcycle.
- 2) Additional Class & Additional Riders need to be submitted on the supplemental form(s). The original entry must be received with or before additional entries will be processed. Additional class/riders must have a separate motorcycle number. It is the rider's responsibility to make sure the correct numbers and class are noted on the bike for each run.
- 3) All riders are required to read the BUB Racing Riders Handbook, as well as the AMA Bonneville Supplementary Rule Book and will be required to sign a statement indicating that he/she has done so.
- 4) Medical forms must be submitted at the same time as the entry form.
- 5) **All riders MUST have proof of current AMA membership (membership card or temporary cards printed from internet memberships are accepted). If your rider is not yet an AMA member, please pre-register with the AMA prior to the event to help keep the line waiting time down. You can sign up instantly on line www.amadirectlink.com.**
- 6) Please check your class against the AMA rules. Corrections in class will only be permitted at registration prior to scrutineering.
- 7) We will call/email confirmation of the receipt of your entry form. Confirmation packets will be mailed in early August with your pre-registration details. Do not lose this packet- bring it with you to the event.

AMA's Statement of Responsibility:

You have voluntarily entered an AMA sanctioned competition meet. An AMA sanction indicates that this meet is listed in the Association's official calendar and that the AMA rules for competition may be used as a guideline. It does not indicate that the track has been inspected or approved by the Association, nor does it indicate that the officials have been trained or accredited by the Association, nor does it indicate that your safety has been assured by any AMA authority or the organizer.

Motorsports are inherently dangerous. You should take part in this competition based on your own assessment of your abilities. If you have not personally inspected the course, we urge you to do so. You have been provided an opportunity to practice under non-competitive conditions. If you have not practiced, we urge you to contact the referee (officials) at this time. You are responsible for the quality and condition of your motorcycle and protective apparel.

The organizer does not provide medical insurance coverage. We urge you not to compete in motorsports without adequate personal medical insurance coverage. If you have any doubts at this time about your personal abilities to participate in this meet, if you do not have adequately prepared yourself and your equipment, or if you believe personal insurance coverage are not adequate to compensate you for any loss that might occur, we urge you to notify the organizer who will immediately refund your entry fee. Spectators witnessing these meets thereby assume all risks for any injury or damages resulting therefrom.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY... THE FINE PRINT

- It is the participant/spectators' responsibility to read the conditions of entry. The AMA, FIM, promoters, officials, sponsors and vendors will not be held responsible for any consequences that results from persons not reading and understanding the conditions.
- Participants are not officially entered until the entry form and entry fees have been received by BUB racing and processed.
- Rider medical insurance is the responsibility of the participant. Contact the AMA for details on their rider medical insurance policies available for participants in AMA sanctioned meets.
- All riders must have a current driver's license at the time of the meet from the state/country in which they reside (minor excluded with Parent/Guardian authorization).
- Any minors that are attending the meet must have both of their parents/guardians sign the Minor Release Form at the gate. If the minor's parents/ guardians will not be accompanying them to the meet, the supervising adult must have a notarized Consent Letter authorizing them to sign on behalf of the parents/guardians. For more details contact BUB Racing Inc. or the AMA.
- All riders are deemed responsible for the actions of their family, crew and personal photographers. All participants understand that violation of the rules and procedures by any one they are responsible for, can lead to fines and forfeiture of their competition privileges.
- All persons entering the meet, including spectators, agree to respect the salt surface and will make every effort to protect this resource. Trash and recycling is to be carried out or disposed of in the dumpsters provided.
- All persons entering the meet are required to sign a liability waiver form before being admitted (at entry gate).
- Meet promoters reserve the right to refuse entry, or to eject anyone from the meet for any reason.
- Land Speed Racing is a dangerous activity and you enter this meet with that knowledge. BUB Racing Inc., FIM, AMA, BLM, their sponsors and affiliates will not be liable for any action in which you volunteer that may put you at risk.
- Entry fee, less \$125 (\$50 RWB, \$50 Additional Class/Rider) processing fee, will be refunded in the meet of cancellation by BUB Racing Inc. due to adverse weather or course conditions prior to August 30th, 2009. No refund requests honored after the pre-registration closing date should an entrant choose not to attend.
- The BUB Motorcycle Speed Trials is open to wheel driven record attempts only. No other propulsion entries will be accepted.
- If you do not agree to any of the above conditions, please contact the meet promoters and have your entry form withdrawn, and entry fees refunded before any participation in the meet.
