



FIM ENTRY CHECKLIST. INTERNATIONAL PARTICIPANTS

In order to compete for a world record at the BUB Motorcycle Speed Trials, advanced preparation is required. This checklist is designed to assist in the process to ensure all the appropriate paperwork is submitted. This checklist applies to INTERNATIONAL residents only.

FIM entries consist of 3 parts: (a) Rider Licensing, (b) World Record Attempt Application, (c) BUB Speed Trials entry. All 3 parts must be completed in full and submitted to BUB Racing by the stated deadlines.

- Get a licensing (a) and record attempt (b) application from your FMN (Your national FIM representative)
 - Get an entry form (c) from BUB Racing Inc (available online)
 - READ the FIM rule books
 - Complete FIM license application (a) documentation required by your FMN
 - You must get a 'Rider Release/Permission to Start' letter from your FMN to be permitted to ride in the USA (Canadian riders exempt). This must be sent to BUB Racing with your entry form.
 - Complete *WORLD RECORD ATTEMPT APPLICATION* form (b)
 - Rider must sign the form
 - Include with your application:
 - o Photos certifying the condition of the machine (2 photos with fairing and 2 without fairings), the effectiveness of the safety points (photos of each point) (see art 018.15 FIM world record rule book).
 - Submit forms to your FMN **NO LATER than JUNE 30th 2009**. Your FMN may have an earlier deadline. Application **MUST** reach the FIM at least 2 months in advance of the attempt.
 - Send/Fax Copy of *World Record Attempt Application* to BUB Racing with your entry form (the form only- no photos required)
 - Complete BUB Speed Trials Entry Form (available online).
 - Check FIM Box and submit BUB entry fee, payable to BUB Racing Inc.
 - Submit to BUB Racing **NO LATER than JUNE 1st 2009**.
